*RV's / Motor homes cannot be used for Inhabitation/Sleeping purposes *

Code Compliance Safety Requirements / Documents

Home inspection safety requirements:

- Required functioning interconnected smoke detectors:
 - Wireless or wire in all must communicate, test one all detectors go off
 - o In all bedrooms, living rooms, dens, or game rooms
 - (not required in hallways)
 - Gas appliances CO (carbon monoxide) detectors are required within 20 feet of gas appliance
- Required fire extinguishers in plain sight and in clearly marked locations
 - Must be model 2A10BC or larger per floor
- Required GFCI protected outlets in wet areas (kitchen, bathrooms, laundry)

Documents needed in home for guests:

Vacation Rentals must provide the following information to their rental customers per PCC 4-9-6 (K). All information / documents below are Required in the rental for guests.

- 24-hour contact phone number for local responsible party for the property
- Trash pickup information and rules for storage on the exterior of the property.
- Good Neighbor Brochure
- Copy of the City of Prescott 4-9 (Vacation Rental Code)
- Copy of Noise Ordinance 5-4 (Noise levels not to exceed)

*Once inspection is completed and passed you will receive these to add to you documents above:

- Vacation Rental Occupancy (Maximum number of permitted to stay in the rental unit)
- Registration

In code 4-9 guest must be aware of:

- Notice that the renter may be cited, fined, and or evicted for violations of state law; cite code; or violations of this chapter.
- Notice that failure to conform to occupancy limits is a violation of this chapter.
